

Drop and Add Policy

Grades 9 &10:

- 1- Students are obliged to take all mandatory subjects (ELA – Science – Math – Social Studies – Ministry Subjects – French – PE – Art or Computer).
- 2- Students are not permitted to drop or add any subject.
- 3- Failing in any course will be subject to Promotion Policy and Graduation Policy.
- 4- Students who did not take Foreign Language at a previous school/division and joined MLS American Division in Grade 9 or above may submit a written request to be exempted from the Foreign Language credit requirements and drop the French course, on the understanding that not having a Foreign Language disqualifies them from faculties such as Linguistics and Liberal Arts.

Grade 11:

- 1- All students are obliged to take the following subjects: ELA – Social Studies – French – Ministry Subjects – PE.
- 2- All students are obliged to choose between one of the two subjects below in each category of subjects (a, b, c). Students are allowed to drop/add subjects (change their choice) during the first 2 weeks of the school year – with parent consent and once changed the decision is irreversible:
 - a. Art and Design or Computer Science
 - b. Chemistry or Environmental Science
 - c. Advanced Algebra II or Regular Algebra II
- 3- Failing in any course will be subject to Promotion Policy and Graduation Policy.
- 5- Students who did not take Foreign Language at a previous school/division and joined MLS American Division in Grade 9 or above may submit a written request to be exempted from the Foreign Language credit requirements and drop the French course, on the understanding that not having a Foreign Language disqualifies them from faculties such as Linguistics and Liberal Arts.

Grade 12:

- 1- All students are obliged to take ELA, Economics, Psychology and Ministry subjects
- 2- All students are obliged to choose between one of the two subjects below in each category of subjects (a, b, c). Students are allowed to drop/add subjects (change their choice) during the first 2 weeks of the school year – with parent consent and once changed the decision is irreversible:
 - a. Advanced Math or Business Math or Accounting

- b. Art and Design or Computer Science or Advanced Biology
 - c. Physics or Sociology
- 3- Students are allowed to drop one of the subjects above, without adding another, at any time during the school year on the following conditions:
- i. Maintain at least 5 credits in Grade 12
 - ii. Adhere to using this class as study time in the assigned classroom
 - iii. Exemplary history of conduct
 - iv. Obtain parent consent
 - v. The decision is irreversible
- 4- Students are allowed to drop Psychology (mandatory Social Science) any time during the school year on the following conditions:
- i. An accumulative GPA at MLS High School of 3.5 or above
 - ii. Course load of 2 or more Grade 12 Scientific subjects
 - iii. Maintain at least 5 credits in Grade 12
 - iv. Exemplary history of conduct
 - v. Obtain parent consent
 - vi. The decision is irreversible
